Job Position: Landscape Maintenance Assistant

The Landscape Maintenance Assistant is responsible for working as a team member under the direct supervision of the Landscape Maintenance Foreman to ensure proper maintenance of the grounds and use of equipment to complete tasks as assigned. The candidate can expect to work outdoors in a mix of weather conditions and be able to perform maintenance duties to ensure employee safety during inclement weather by removing debris, snow, and ice from communal walkways and spaces.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Performs landscape maintenance duties such as mowing, fertilizer application, weed control, aeration, spring clean-up, fall clean-up, trimming, and pruning.
- Operate a variety of mechanical equipment including but not limited to bed edgers, commercial mowers, blowers, dump trailers, chainsaws, line trimmers, and tillers.
- Perform landscape enhancement activities such as mulch application, plantings, top soil application, lawn seeding, watering and monitors seasonal annual planting and designing of annual flower beds.
- Maintain and remove weeds and dead plants, prune overgrown limbs and leaves, rake fallen leaves and remove debris.
- Remove tree limbs, overgrowth, and other hazards, use leaf blower to clear walkways and pedestrian areas after lawn maintenance.
- Treat lawn and landscaping with pesticides to remove harmful insects, use of safety and protective equipment.
- Provides proper upkeep of sidewalks, driveways, parking lots, fountains, planters, burial sites and other ground features as appropriate.
- Properly store and handle all equipment, tools, sprinklers, etc.
- Assist with snow removal, when necessary.
- Develops and maintains excellent customer service with current and potential clients at a measured rate of 95% or greater.
- Performs other duties as required.
